Shelter Animals sent to fix a friend, adoption of animals possibly adding a day to send adoptable animals before they are adopted. We have approximately 150 per month. We would like to have any and all animals that are adopted fixed prior to going out. Closing the gap.

State Inspector should be arriving this week to do yearly inspection.

We are looking into doing a non-breed aspect on all of our dogs, American Shelter dog small, medium, and large. Rather than stereo typing dogs. Look at defining behavior problems based of the dog and not the breed. Looking for the thoughts of the board.

Dr. Sheegog is asking what about rental and homeowners insurance, who is liable. What about the military community. Possible PR problem if we are not telling the truth. Worried about base controversy, and people may not be honest.

Mr. Martin explains the liability would fall on the adopter not the shelter to determine if the dog fits the standards for the insurance or rental company.

We have now started our national advertising for Vet, we will be changing the wording from Shelter vet to vet. We have hired a new Vet tech for Wake Cty they start March 5th. We are working on the 2019 budget and requesting 3 new ACO' officer and an Animal Cruelty/Bite investigator. Looking at the purchase of new vehicles.
