


OVERDOSE FATALITIES BY YEAR



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The State Opioid Response Intensive Family Preservation Services Program

Serving Onslow and Pender Counties

Coastal Horizons' SOR-IFPS Program, is a therapeutic family approach, lasting on average 8 weeks, and is intended to empower and equip Child Welfare involved families with a history of opioid use to gain resources and skills necessary to maintain in-home placement of their children ages birth-17years.

The SOR-IFPS program includes: Crisis management, support with opioid use treatment and recovery, intensive case management, individual and/or family therapy, skills training, behavioral supports, preservation or reunification focus, and other rehabilitative supports. These services are provided in the home with the family as well as within the community to prevent the need for out-of-home placements or stabilize a reunification; prevent further abuse and neglect; and enhance social development.

- Flexible scheduling options available
- Services are provided by an experienced and trained Family Preservation Specialist
- 24/7/365 on-call availability for crisis situations
- Services can begin within 48 hours of referral, with no assessment needed, contingent on availability
- Services are individualized and designed to be unique to your family's needs and abilities
- Specialist maintains relationships with and works closely with Schools, Juvenile Justice, DSS, and other community agencies
- Services are available regardless of insurance status
- Specialist have a strong knowledge of the unique challenges of opioid use recovery
