FREE OR LOW-COST SERVICES

- Fees for many services are based on a sliding fee scale so that people with low incomes pay less (or nothing) for a service.
 - No one is denied essential services, such as communicable disease testing, family planning, prenatal or child health, because he or she cannot pay. Even if money is owed to the Health Department, people are not turned away or required to pay up-front for essential services.
