5 PRACTICES THAT HELP YOUR CHILD TO BE READY TO READ

Every time you read the same book, your child gets something new out of it. Repetition is necessary and good!

Allowing children to practice making lines, curves, and circles will later inspire them to write letters on purpose.

Just like books, songs have great vocabulary words. Hearing new words in context helps children build their vocabularies.

Playing rhyming and letter sound games can help children learn the structural sounds of words.

Studies show that children benefit from time to play on their own and the ability to use their imaginations.
