In any multi-seat race, a Straight Party vote is a vote for ALL candidates of that party. If you individually vote for any candidate in a multi-seat race, you must also individually select all other candidates in that race for whom you wish to vote in order for your vote to count.</p> <p>d. If you do not select a Straight Party below, you may vote by marking each office separately.</p> <p>e. A Straight Party vote does not vote for US President and Vice President, unaffiliated candidates, or nonpartisan offices, issues or referenda.</p>	<p><input type="radio"/> Walter H.
