### Position Responsibilities

Performs difficult protective service work supervising and enforcing the areas of security and safety at the County Airport; does related work as required. Work is sometimes performed under emergency conditions and may involve personal hazard. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Airport Director. Supervision is exercised over subordinate personnel.

### Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

Knowledge of:

- Police methods, practices and procedures;
- Local, State and Federal laws and TSA security and airport operation procedures;
- The principles and techniques of emergency medical care.

Ability to:

- Deal courteously, but firmly, with the public;
- Analyze situations and to adopt quick, effective and reasonable course of action with due regard to surrounding hazards and circumstances;
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with associates and the general public.

### Minimum Education and Experience Requirements

Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from an accredited college or university with coursework in criminal justice or related courses and two to five years of law enforcement experience.

### Special Requirements

Must be a graduate of the Basic Law Enforcement Training Course and possess a certification as a Law Enforcement Officer in accordance with the State of North Carolina Standards for Law Enforcement Officers or Sheriff's Training Standards. Must possess a valid driver's license and be in compliance with the Onslow County's insurance regulations.
