Position Responsibilities

Performs responsible protective service work in providing emergency medical services to critically ill and injured patients under emergency conditions. Responding to emergency calls, providing emergency medical services and transportation; preparing and maintaining detailed records. Work is performed under the regular supervision of the Emergency Medical Services Captain, Paramedic Lieutenant and/or Paramedic Sergeant.

NOTE: Each position will not exceed 780 hours of work annually.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

Knowledge of:

- Emergency medical care techniques and procedures;
- Advanced life support methods, procedures and equipment;
- Medical terminology;
- Methods, materials, practices, techniques and equipment required for emergency medical treatment;
- Street system and physical lay-out of the County.

Ability to:

- Perform duties in emergency situations and to evaluate and differentially diagnose patient's conditions and communicate clearly with professional medical personnel;
- Perform general emergency medical treatment and specialized cardiac treatment;
- Respond quickly and calmly in emergency and stress situations;
- Follow oral and written instructions;
- Establish and maintain cooperative relations with physicians, fellow employees and the public;
- Prepare reports.

Minimum Education and Experience Requirements

Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from high school and completion of one year of community college with major coursework in emergency medical services supplemented by required emergency medical services training and some experience in emergency medical services (EMT-I work).

Special Requirements

Possession of a valid driver's license in the State of North Carolina. Possession and maintenance of current certificates issued by the State of North Carolina for Emergency Medical Technician Basic.
