Position Responsibilities

This position encompasses initial on-going case work services to pregnant and parenting women, who utilize services of the Onslow County Health Department. Services are also extended to family members and other individuals who significantly impact the patient's well-being. Works in conjunction with multidisciplinary team to ensure the patient accesses necessary medical, nutritional, educational, financial, and social services necessary to ensure a healthy pregnancy and early parenting outcomes.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

Knowledge of:

- Social work principle techniques, practices, and their application to specific casework, group work and community organizations;

Ability to:

- Demonstrate a holistic approach to working with families;
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with administrative superiors, clients and their families, civic, medical, social and religious organizations;
- Express ideas clearly and concisely and to plan and execute work effectively.

Minimum Education and Experience Requirements

Bachelor's degree from an accredited school of social work; or a four-year degree in a human services field or related curriculum including at least one year of social work or counseling experience; or graduation from a four-year college or university and two years experience in the rehabilitation counseling, pastoral counseling, or a related human service field providing experience in the techniques of casework, group work, or community organizations; or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Prefer background in health and human services working with pregnant women and their families.

Special Requirements

Copies of transcripts with date of degree awarded must be submitted with application. Must have a valid driver's license and be in compliance with the Onslow County's insurance regulations.
