How to Make a Wreath


Materials:

3—Pipe Cleaners

Scissors (*optional*)

Instructions:

Step 1: Take your two matching colored pipe cleaners and twist one end of the pipe cleaners together.



Step 2: Put one of your fingers in-between the two pipe cleaners and then twist the pipe cleaners around your finger at least twice. This will create a small circle.



Step 3: Repeat Step 2 but be sure to leave an extra bit of untwisted pipe cleaner at the end.



Step 4: Next take the untwisted end of the pipe cleaner and twist the end at the beginning, creating a circle/wreath!



Step 5: Now stretch out the circles.

Step 6: Grab the other pipe cleaner and create a bow. Loop each end of the pipe cleaner to create a bow shape. Attach the bow to the wreath by looping the straight ends of the bow around the part of the wreath where you twisted the ends together. *Take the ends of the bow underneath the wreath, then **bring them back up and over the middle of the bow ears, ***securing it to the wreath.

Use scissors to cut some length off the bow if you choose.



Reindeer Card Template



Materials:

Reindeer Template

Glue Stick

1/2 White Cardstock Paper

Instructions:

Step 1: Cut out all shapes & fold the white cardstock paper in half.

Step 2: Glue the brown face down first onto the white cardstock paper.

Step 3: Glue the black eyes, then red nose, and finally antlers onto the reindeer's face.

Step 4: Decorate the inside of your card!

How to Make a Paper Snowman

Materials:

Snowman Template

Scissors

Black Marker/Crayon

Glue Stick

Instructions:

Step 1: Cut out all the shapes of the Snowman Template Sheet.

Step 2: Take the three strips of white paper and glue the ends together, creating 3 separate paper rolls. Glue these rolls onto the colored construction paper; the smallest roll at the top.



Step 3: Next take the black half circle and apply glue onto the white side. Stick the half circle on top of the snowman, black side up.



Step 4: Take the black paper strip and make a paper roll out of it; glue the ends together.

Step 5: Take the red thin strip of paper and glue it at the bottom of the black paper roll.



Step 6: Apply glue to the back of the black roll and stick it at the top of the black half circle, creating the snowman's hat.

Step 7: Add a bit of glue to the end of the branches and stick them in the center white roll.

Step 8: Apply glue to the back of the orange nose. Place it in the center on the top white roll, creating the nose of the snowman.



Step 9: Draw eyes, a mouth, and buttons of the snowman with a black marker/crayon.







